



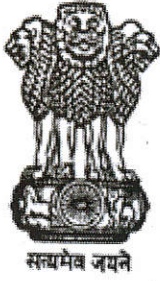

(i) Page No 4 specific condition (iii) shall be read as, "Total fresh water requirement shall not exceed 1885 KLD, 1885 KLD and 1375 KLD based on the feedstock used C heavy molasses, B heavy molasses and cane syrup respectively. Fresh water requirement shall be met from River Krishna. Prior permission shall be obtained from the concerned regulatory authority/CGWA in this regard, and renewed from time to time. No ground water recharge shall be permitted within the premises"

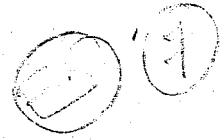

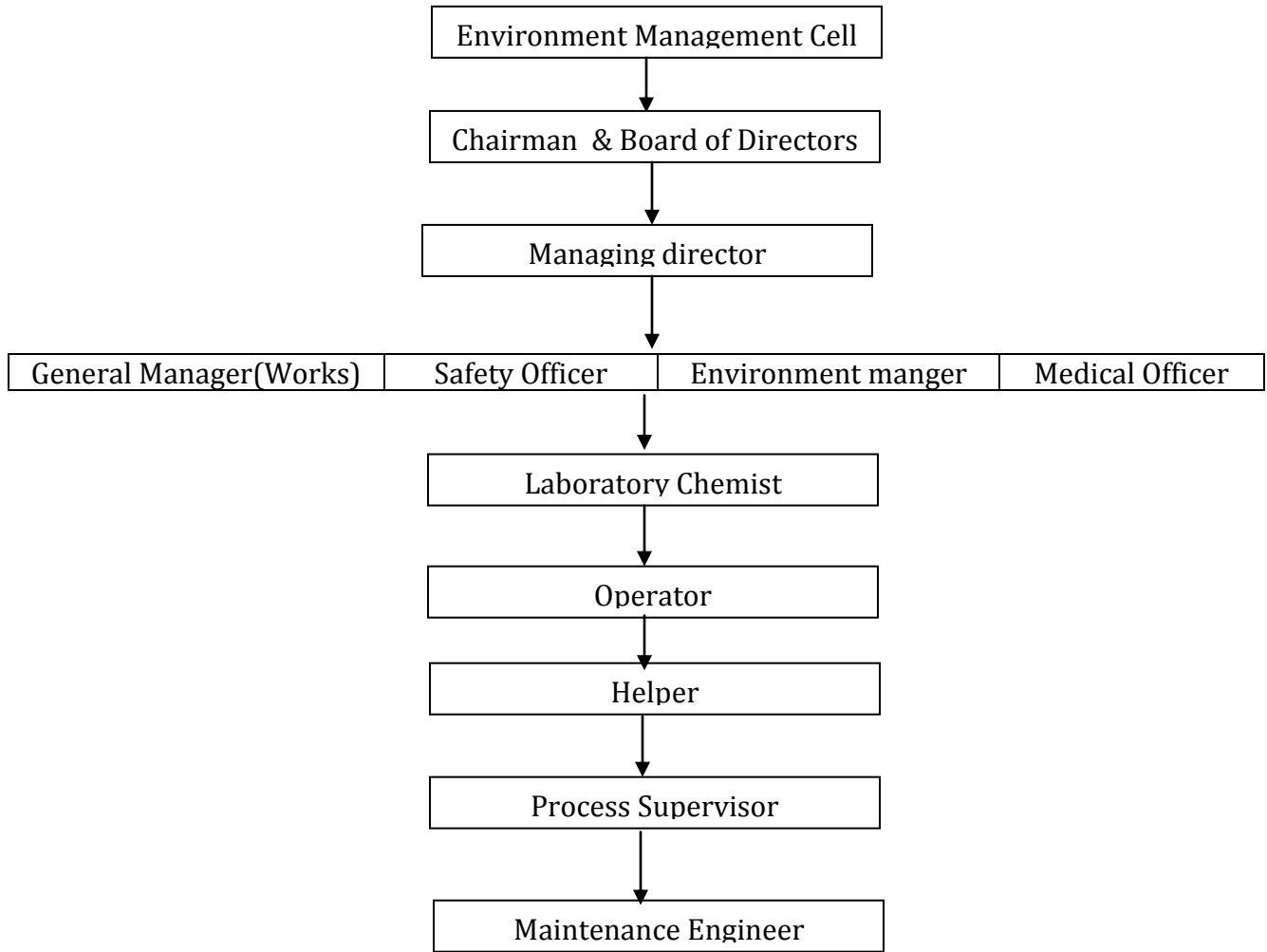

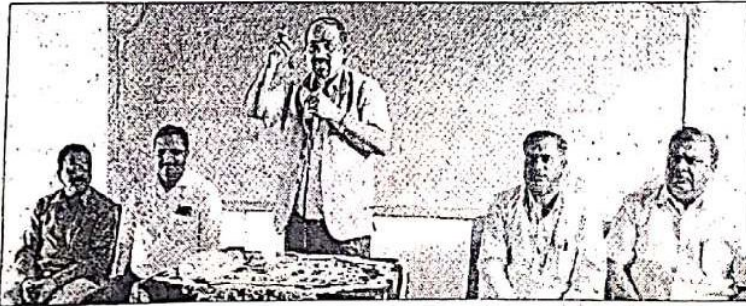
